Code of Ethics Policy

The Island Elementary School District is committed to the exhibition of sportsmanlike and ethical behaviors in all athletics. All games must be safe, courteous, fair, controlled and orderly for all athletes and fans alike. Violators of the Code of Ethics may be asked to leave the premises, and if the violator is an athlete, be pulled from the game and face further consequences up to and including removal from the team.

Code of Ethics

Athletes of Island Elementary School District will be able...

- To emphasize the proper ideas of sportsmanship, ethical conduct and fair play
- To stress the values derived from playing the game fairly
- To show courtesy to visiting teams and officials
- To respect the integrity and judgment of sports officials
- To achieve a thorough understanding and acceptance of the rules of the game and the standards of eligibility
- To encourage leadership, use of initiative and good judgment by the players on a team
- To recognize that the purpose of athletics is to promote the physical, mental, moral, social and emotional well being of the individual players

Eligible athletes must care for equipment/uniforms checked out to them:

- Maintain appearance and condition of equipment/uniforms.
- Each athlete is responsible for returning equipment/uniforms to the coach immediately at season's end.
- Athletes will not be allowed to participate in subsequent sports until they have been cleared from previous sport.
- Each athlete is financially responsible for damage beyond normal wear and tear and/or loss of equipment/uniforms.

Eligibility Requirements

In grades 4-8, the student's classroom teacher shall determine whether the student is eligible to participate in each scheduled activity. The classroom teacher shall consider the following factors when deciding whether to permit the student to participate:

Academic Eligibility

- *Maintain a grade point average of 2.0 (C average)
- *Receive no "F" grades
- *Grades will be considered on progress reports and/or report cards

Citizenship Eligibility

- *Conduct observed during the appropriate grading period
